The Obaek Jang-goon Gallery of Jeju Stone Park holds the exhibition <Lee Eun-hee, the Beauty of Hanji Paper Art>.

Lee Eun-hee, an expert in hanji paper and paper art, expresses a wholly different world of texture with the jumchi technique of kneading water-soaked hanji paper thousands of times. This exhibition showcases diverse works created by complementing Korean traditional hanji techniques with her unique artistic soul.

The installation, which was supervised by Cathy Rapin, French professor, poet, and theatrical director, portrays the strength of hanji paper as a ‘material of life, vitalizing the space’ by imbuing hanji paper works with three-dimensional power through diversity in both color and texture.

Commenting on the most important aspect of jumchi work, the artist says one must know ‘the moment of pause, and where to pause.’ Amid COVID-19, when we have paused our routines, it is hoped that this exhibition provides you with the opportunity for composure and relaxation for your body and soul through the beauty of hanji paper.
